

Annual Resident Evening & Weekend Permit Parking Regulations & Information

Hours:

The Annual Resident Evening and Weekend Permit is valid during the days and hours listed below only.

Monday to Friday - 6:00pm to Midnight
Saturday & Sunday - 10:00am to Midnight

Parking facilities:

The Annual Resident Evening and Weekend Permit is valid at the following locations only.

- Chester-Maple Garage
- Hamilton-Main Garage
- Library Garage
- Lexington-Grove West Garage
- Lexington-Grove East Garage
- TransCenter Garage
- Longview-Cromwell Garage
- Lyon Place Garage

Where to park at each location:

At the Library Garage you are permitted to park at any valid meter or permit space. At all other facilities you must park within the designated Permit Parking areas. Look for permit area signs. Please call (914)422-1232 for assistance.

Parking Regulations:

- Park within lines
- Park head on -- backing in prohibited
- No trucks over 6500 lbs gross vehicle weight
- Vehicles must not exceed height limit posted at parking facility
- Permit parking areas may be relocated to facilitate maintenance functions
- At the Library Garage, you may park at any valid meter or permit space. At all other facilities you must park within the designated Permit Parking Areas.
- Display only a current valid permit

Permit Information:

Proof of residency is required as follows.

- 1) Valid NYS driver's license; and
- 2) Copy of current lease, tax bill, utility bill, or White Plains Recreation ID; and
- 3) Valid NYS registration for vehicle to be permitted.

****All documents must have same WP address!!**

Permits are non-transferable and non-refundable.

Permits are valid for one passenger vehicle only, no commercial vehicles.

Permits are sold annually for the period January - December only.

Use of a permit which has been reported lost or stolen, or which has been altered or copied is a crime and violators will be subject to criminal penalties.

Where to place your permit:

Parking permits must be placed in the provided plastic permit holder. Permit holder must be affixed to the window on the Driver's Side of the vehicle as far toward the rear as possible (see graphic below). Permit must be clearly visible at all times. For additional assistance speak with a Department of Parking staff member when you purchase your permit.
